POWDERED CHARCOAL PORTRAIT WORKSHOP

Lauren Peterson is teaching a workshop at the art league on Saturday, October 28, from 9:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., and spaces are still available. This workshop presents an excellent opportunity to learn a new medium, powdered charcoal, and to create a portrait, first from a photograph of your choosing, then from working with a clothed model. Students will learn how to manipulate the powdered charcoal with kneaded erasers and brushes and water and may also use vine charcoal or charcoal pencils. The workshop is \$60, but students do not need to provide any of their materials; a \$15 fee to be collected by the instructor will include all supplies, including paper and powdered charcoal, and the modeling fee. - Treasurer Kandi Husarik reported that our expenses are holding steady and while our income is at a
 low point, it is a cyclical problem that should correct itself in the next few months. Fall classes are up
 37% but part of that may be because enrollment was down last year with all the construction. The
 life drawing workshop is more than paying for itself and our printing and postage costs are way
 down
- The board awarded a Life Membership to Ann Johnson who has put in many hours of work over the
 course of several years editing the Newsletter, managing the staffing of the front desk and doing
 countless other things for the league. Everyone on the board agreed it was well deserved.

Work includes preparing, editing, posting and sending of the newsletter and/or email blasts. This can be split between two (2) people. The newsletter is done monthly, while the e-blasts are done on an as needed basis. Both involve computer knowledge in word, editing (copying, cutting and pasting articles, inserting photos, rearranging to fit space). Current programs used are Microsoft Word & Publisher files. Also involves uploading to our current email service provider. If there is a way you could help out, please contact Ann or myself for more info.

Also PLEASE REMEMBER. Every exhibiting member is required to help the art league for a minimum of 4 hours a year. If you exhibit in Yuletide Treasures that doubles to 8 hours. 
