



Board Notes

 The big news this month is that the board approved moving ahead with the new computer/ POS system and website redesign. Dan Anderson, who



headed the committee, presented a detailed proposal based on an enormous amount of research. The cost for the first year will be \$12,260 with an annual cost of \$4,620 the following years. The league has received grant money to cover the costs. Dan reminded the board that this is a big project which will be time-consuming and involve adjusting to changes in the way we operate. Board members expressed the belief that it is long overdue and will be more than worth the difficulty.

- New Treasurer Pat Thorson reported that our financial situation is solid. Our Fiscal Year-end Report showed we took in just under \$150,000 for classes, \$4,870 in gallery sales, \$16,073 from the gift shop and Yuletide Treasures and \$18,165 from membership. Pat projected a budget for 2020 and asked the board to let her know if there were any areas that needed to be adjusted.
- The annual meeting was a big success. The turnout was great and as promised, President Kay Wahlgren kept the business portion of the meeting short and informative. The artwork in the Volunteer Art Show was creative. There were delicious hors d'oeuvres, sweets, wine and lots of lively conversation; and one lucky attendee won a \$100 gift certificate.
- New Membership VP Nancy Nolan reported that there are now 378 members which accounted for \$17,360 in income.
 She has completed updating the new member packets.
- It feels like summer has just started and VP Education Nancy Anderson announced that work has already begun on the fall schedule. Likewise VP of Activities Sue Thomas reported that she has already filled three slots on the fall program schedule.
