With just a few primary colors and white paint, create amazing scenes. Acrylic is fast drying and looks like oil paint, but is water soluble. Colors mix well and texture can be added with the use of molding paste and using a palette knife.

REGISTRATION AND PAYMENT

Full payment is due at the time of registration prior to the first class. No class registration may be accepted without payment.

In person registration: credit card, cash, check.

Mail registration: credit card or check.

MISSED CLASSES: Classes are sold as a full session. Refunds will not be issued for missed classes. Missed classes may be made up in classes taught by the same teacher at their discretion. Students whose schedules will cause them to miss a significant number of classes in a session, may buy a single class at \$25 each on the day of the class if the class is not full and the teacher approves.

REFUND POLICY AND CANCELLATIONS: Refunds will be made only if cancellation is made 5 business days prior to the first class. There will be a \$5 charge for processing a refund. Classes with insufficient enrollment will be canceled. All refunds will be handled through the mail. The DPAL reserves the right to change dates, cancel, postpone, split, or combine classes.

TRANSFERRING CLASSES: Class registrations cannot be transferred from one class to another. Students may cancel a class, ask for a refund (If 5 days or more before the class begins), and then select and pay for another class to replace it. There will be a \$5 processing fee for refund requests.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE: Class fees can be waived upon presentation of evidence of financial need. Call for further information.
