Yellow Medium

Quinacridone Magenta

Cadmium Red

Cerulean Blue

Note: If you would like to start with just white, yellow, red and ultramarine blue to start, you can add the other colors later, and other colors can be made by mixing.

Brushes: An assortment of one large flat, smaller flat, a small round brush. Synthetic brushes work well.

Plastic palette knife

Disposable palette, butcher tray, or paper plate

Paper towels or rags

Apron or old shirt

Paint on canvas board or stretch canvas. 9 x 12 is a good size to start. You can also paint on canvas paper pad or gesso on mason board. Dick Blick's, Dollar Tree, and Five and Below are places you can purchase canvases inexpensively and they are great for beginners.

Newspaper or plastic table cover to protect table from paint drips. A plastic tablecloth can be re-used for each class.
