## Beginning Watercolor with Vicki Liszewski

If you already have watercolor supplies please bring them. I will thoroughly discuss supplies and give a longer handout in the first class. You can purchase your supplies in stages. If you have questions contact me at <u>liszewskiv@gmail.com</u> or 630-267-4812.

Paper	one sheet (22 x 30") of Arches 300 lb. cold press, we will divide this into quarters and it will last all session
Brushes	one 1/2" flat, one #8 round, one large brush to apply water such as a 2" flat, a Hake brush or a mop brush (be sure they are for watercolor, not acrylic painting)
Palette	a watercolor palette with 16 wells for paint and a lid. Larger is better, but you can use a small palette plus a tray for mixing such as an enamel butcher tray
Water tubs	two small plastic containers such as Glad or Ziplock
Towels	paper towels or a white terry towel
Other	a pencil, a small sketchbook, a kneaded eraser
Paint	5 ml tubes of artist grade watercolor. Good brands are Winsor Newton (not Cotman), Holbein, Daniel Smith, QoR, American Journey, Sennelier, M. Graham
	For the first class you only need Ultramarine Blue (PB29)
	You can add these two warm primary colors by the <b>second class</b> : Cadmium Yellow Pale (PY35) Cadmium Red (PR)

For a complete split primary palette add these cool primaries by the **second** or **third class**: Lemom Yellow (PY3) Alizarin Crimson (PR83) Cobalt Blue (PB28) and/or Cerulean Blue (PB35)

Note: You can save a little money by buying a starter set, don't worry that they are not the exact colors I listed above, they will work just fine. Some good ones are: Daniel Smith Essentials set of six \$37.59
Daniel Smith 3 Primary set \$28.84
QoR Introductory set of six \$31.00
Holbein set of 12. \$56.39
Windsor Newton Travel Tin set of 12. \$83.99
Cheap Joes American Journey 6 Color Beginner Set \$130 (includes brushes, palette and paper)
