**Full payment is due at the time of registration prior to the first class. No class registration will be accepted without full payment.**

**MISSED CLASS:** Classes are sold as a full session and refunds will not issued for any missed class. A missed class may be made up in other classes and times taught by the same teacher at the discretion of the instructor. Any student whose schedules will cause them to miss a significant number of classes in a session, may buy single classes at \$20 each on the day of the class, that is if the class is not full and with instructor approval.

**REFUND POLICY AND CANCELLATIONS:** Refunds will be issued only if cancellation is made at least 5 days prior to the first day of class. There is a \$20 refund handling fee. Refunds will be credited to your credit card or sent by mail if payment was made by check or cash. Classes with insufficient enrollment will be canceled. **TRANSFERRING CLASSES:** Class registrations cannot be transferred from one class to another. Although students can cancel class registration and ask for a refund as long as cancellation occurs **5 business days** or more before the class begins and then select and pay for another class to replace it. NOTE: There will be a \$20 processing fee for refund requests.
