Also called Life Drawing, live figure classes involve a nude model. Without clothes the model can be rendered in a timeless fashion. Stripped of culture and place in time, there is no difference between those figures drawn today and those created in a Renaissance classroom. The nude figure, depending on pose and artistic skill, can suggest every aspect of humanity from the pathetic to the narcissistic or heroic. When you attend a figure drawing class, you are participating in a tradition that is hundreds, possibly thousands of years old. Students render their own artwork, there is no instruction during these sessions. Students may use the medium of their choice. Typically, the model will provide five -5-minute poses for warm up, and then one or two long poses (1-2 hours).

A minimum of 4 students must be registered by Saturday, May 9 in order to cover the model fees and hold the class.

In this class modeled after 19th-century atelier training methods, a setup of anatomical plaster casts will serve as the common reference for participants to hone their oil painting skills. Realistic depiction will be achieved by focusing on tonal values using a limited palette of ivory black, raw umber, and white.

Accuracy of placement and proportion will be attained by eye and hand using sight-size and muscle-memory techniques. Paintings will be constructed using Venetian layering methods, including imprimatura, grisaille, impasto, sfumato, and glazing. During class, students will be provided with the proper brushes, knives, and palettes and instructed on their proper use and care.

A \$40 material fee (paid to the instructor) covers: (3) 37ml tubes of paint, painting medium (as needed from instructor's stock) and, (1) 16" x 20" pre-primed canvas. Class size is limited to 5 students.
